

Rhome Police Department PART-TIME paid Police Officer Position 24 hours a week.

The purpose of this position is to perform duties related to “Community Policing”, concentrate on detection of traffic violations and crime in residential neighborhoods, downtown area, and school zones.

This work schedule for this position is 24 hours each week spread out over 4 to 5 days. The days will be moved each week and there will be day and evening work hours.

The officer will also perform the usual police patrol activities.

Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of police and law enforcement activities. Tasks are service and protection oriented, and includes collecting and dispensing information, arbitrating disputes, providing assistance, protecting and recovering property, preventing and investigating criminal activity, testifying and providing other public protection services. Incumbents perform duties in accordance with state statutes and established departmental policies, procedures, and guidelines. Performs related work as required. Responds to animal code violation reports.

Other job functions:

Due to the nature of the job performed by peace officers, assistance to the Community may take on various forms not listed above. Generally speaking, a peace officer must be willing to take on any task which the officer may be called upon to perform by people in need of assistance or to the benefit of the community.
