

**CITY OF RHOME, TEXAS
RESOLUTION NO. 2020-05**

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Mayor issued a Declaration of Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency for the City of Rhome, Texas resulting from evidence of local community spread during the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019, (COVID-19), and in an effort to respond quickly to prevent and alleviate the suffering of people exposed to and those infected with the virus, as well as those that could potentially be infected or impacted by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating a declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RHOME, TEXAS:


1. That the Declaration of Local Disaster and Public Health Emergency proclaimed for the City of Rhome by the Mayor on March 24, 2020, shall continue until terminated by order of the City Council.
2. Such extension shall apply to any revision of the Declaration necessitated by revisions to rules, regulations and limitations issued by Wise County and the State of Texas Executive Orders or Disaster Declarations issued by those entities for the Coronavirus Disease 2019 public health emergency as applicable to the City of Rhome.
3. That the City's Emergency Management Plan shall continue to be implemented. Any violation of rules, regulations, or directives adopted pursuant to the Emergency Management Plan or the Declaration of Disaster shall be subject to the penalties set forth in the Emergency Management Plan and Section 418.173, Texas Government code.
